

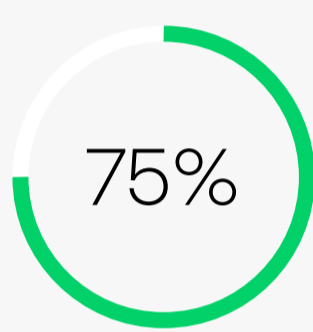

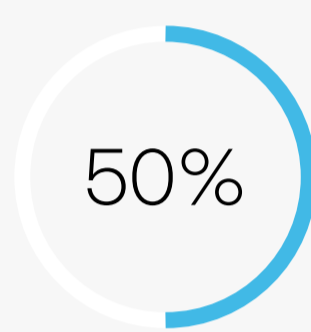
We recently partnered with Censuswide to explore the role of technology in policing, identify where improvements can be made, and look at possible solutions and how to implement them.

Ineffective technology impacts policing and prevents improvement to services

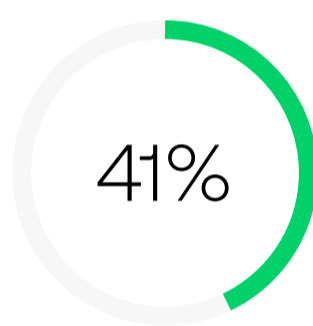


of policing respondents said inefficient tech was an issue

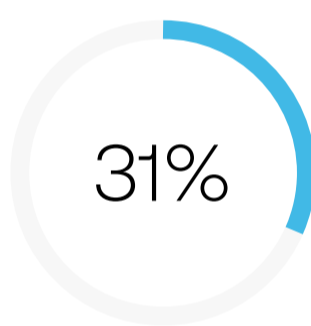


said increasing the efficiency of existing tech investments is their most important operational priority

said user resistance or limited digital skills were an area of difficulty



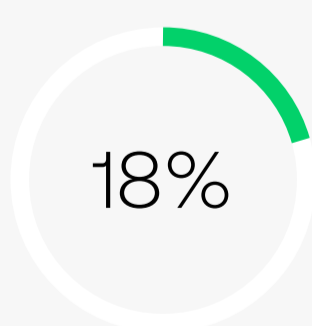
Training is key to closing the skills gap
